## American Legion Chaplain's Corner

Last month I was able to attend an annual ceremony honoring the memory of four military chaplains of different faiths, who drowned on a sinking ship in 1943, after giving away their own life jackets.

If you don't know the story, the Four Chaplains, the SS Dorchester, during WWII was struck and sunk by a torpedo from a German U-Boat in the North Atlantic. As hundreds of scared soldiers panicked and rushed to their lifeboat stations, Jewish Rabbi Alexander D. Goode, Catholic priest John P. Washington, Methodist minister George L. Fox, and Dutch Reformed minister Clark V. Poling, ministered to them as they handed out life jackets to the crew, when they ran out of life jackets they each removed their own and gave them to other crew members.

Some survivors reported the 4 Chaplains were last seen standing together on the deck with their arms linked, saying prayers for their shipmates and singing hymns as they slowly went down with the ship sacrificing their lives for those whom they ministered to.

The scene was immortalized on a U.S. postage stamp and through the efforts of the Chapel of the Four Chaplains which promotes annual Four Chaplains Memorial Services in communities across the nation on or about the Feb. 3 anniversary of the Dorchester sinking.

I was so moved learning about this unselfish act of heroism and interfaith, that I feel compelled to encourage you to read their story. I highly encourage you to attend one of these ceremonies next February, to honor these heroes. Post 35 hosts this ceremony every year on Feb 3rd.


